1. Rye Yacht Club Origin

A number of resident, weekend resident, and camping families whose members sailed off the beach at Rye decided to organise and run a yacht race on New Year's Day, 1970. The race objectives were to blow away the dregs of an over-indulgent New Year's Eve celebration and to provide some fun for families and friends. Six boats eventually started in an exciting, carnival atmosphere. The race concluded with the winner receiving a magnificent trophy laboriously crafted from assorted empty cans carefully covered with aluminum foil and garlanded with toilet paper bunting. All participants received a memento of the occasion and the bookmaker made a killing! The event was so successful that it was repeated in 1971 and attracted thirteen starters. A meeting of interested families was convened during the Australia Day weekend in 1971. At this meeting, it was resolved to conduct a race every Sunday through to Labour Day in March. This program proved to be very popular, and led to a further meeting on Sunday, 30 May 1971, at which RYE YACHT CLUB was officially formed by some twenty-five families. A constitution was prepared and adopted on 2 July 1972.

The Club became a member of the Victorian Yachting Council (now Yachting Victoria) in October 1972.

Originally, the club operated on the beach opposite Ozone Street, but in 1974, moved to a foreshore enclosure opposite Lyons Street. In 1982 the Club moved to the present site, an enclosure of 60 meters by 20 meters. The Clubhouse was built with funds raised by members over the previous years, and officially opened on 31st March 1985. The Club canteen was registered with the Health Department of Victoria in 1992.

In 2004, the western upper deck area became an enclosed room adjacent to the existing committee room, creating a large room suitable for training or recreational purposes.

6. Club Enclosure and Facilities

6.1. Access

6.1.1 A member has the right of access to the Enclosure at any time.

6.1.2 An Enclosure Key/Proximity Fob is available for a fee on application to the Club Registrar.

6.2. Boat Storage

6.2.1 Off the Beach Boats of Sailing Members only may be stored within the Enclosure, provided:

- i. A Rack or Open Space Storage fee has been paid.
- ii. The boat is occupying the rack or space allocated by the Yardmaster.
- iii. In a rack the boat must be dismasted and securely tied to the rack. The mast must be tied to the rack or stored in the mast-rack.
- iv. In the Open Space Storage, the boat must be stored on or with a beach trolley.

6.2.2 The Duty Committee Person can approve short term or overnight boat storage for Regattas, consecutive club sailing days, and other special events. In these circumstances, boats must be stored so that they will not obstruct access to the beach for other stored boats.

6.3. Facilities

6.3.1 A member has the right to use the club facilities of toilets, enclosure yard and BBQ area.

6.3.2 Access to Control Tower, Canteen, Garage, Sailing Sub-Committee storage area, and Cleaners storage area is restricted to members of the responsible Committee, Sub Committee, and members rostered for duty to the area.

6.3.3 The Garage and Canteen areas are security protected by an entry alarm system. Access on non-club/sailing days is only available to members by contact with Club House Officer or Flag Officer

6.3.4 Use of Club Facilities for other than club activities or by non-members may be arranged with the Registrar subject to approval by the Committee.

6.4. General

6.4.1 Members using the club enclosure on non-club activity days are responsible to ensure all gates are kept locked.

6.5. Club Duty Rosters

6.5.1 To enable the Club to operate sailing events, Club members can expect to be rostered for duty in either Race Management (Control Tower, Patrol Boat, tractor

driving) or Club Support (Canteen, club maintenance) functions during the sailing season.

6.5.2 Duty rosters will be published before the start of the sailing season on *DutyMan*. If unable to undertake a rostered duty, members are responsible for arranging a suitable substitute at least 24 hours prior to the day, and advise the Sailing Sub Committee member responsible for duty rosters in writing accordingly.

6.5.3 Members interested in undertaking Race Management and Club Support roles on a more regular or permanent basis are invited to do so by contacting the Club Captain.

6.6. Responsibility

6.6.1 All boats and gear left in the Enclosure are stored at the owners' risk.

6.7. Parking of Vehicles and Launching of Boats.

6.7.1 Motor vehicles must not be parked or left unattended on the Foreshore. Vehicles may only be used to tow boats on trailers to the rigging areas on the seaward side of the club, but must then be removed to the parking areas between the Clubhouse and Pt Nepean Road.

6.7.2 No vehicles are to be driven onto the beach.

6.7.3 Trailerable yachts will only be launched using the Club tractor. All trailerable boats are to be launched at least 1 hour prior to the Race Warning Signal, unless otherwise directed by the Sailing Sub Committee.

6.7.4 After a boat is launched, boat trailers must be removed from the foreshore in front of the club. Trailers can be parked on the foreshore to the west of the clubhouse or between the clubhouse and Pt Nepean Road, or as directed by the Sailing Sub-Committee.

6.7.5 Recovery of yachts and trailers is only permitted using the Club tractor, or as directed by the Sailing Sub-Committee.

Notice of Race

Rye Yacht Club Sailing Season 2016-17

Rye Yacht Club Inc. invites members and visitors to sail in the races of the 2015-16 Sailing Season to be conducted from the Club at Rye, Victoria and as follows:

1. Rules

1.1 The races will be governed by the current rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing RRS 2013-2016, the Special Regulations of the Y.A. 2013-2016, and individual Class Rules, except as any of these are altered by this Notice of Race or by the Sailing Instructions.

Alteration to Racing Rules

1.2 The Racing Rules will be modified in accordance with RRS Rule 86 as follows:

- i. Rule 26 – for “Class” read “Division”.

2. Eligibility and Entry

2.1 The races are open to all classes of Off-the-Beach Boats and Trailerable Yachts.

2.2 In the interests of sailors development and fostering preferred club classes the Sailing Committee recommends the following classes:

- i. Juniors – Opti, Minnow and Open Bic
- ii. Mono Hulls – Sabre, Pacer, Laser and RS Feva
- iii. Catamarans – Paper Tiger, Mosquito, A-Class
- iv. Trailerables - Open

2.3 All skippers shall be either:

- i. financial members of Rye Yacht Club, or
- ii. a visitor being a financial member of another yacht club affiliated with Yachting Australia, or
- iii. a visitor, not being a financial member of another yacht club affiliated with the Yachting Australia but a member of Yachting Australia.

2.4 Visitors under 2.3(ii) or 2.3(iii) will be advised that they are able to participate in a maximum three days of club racing, after which such visitor either becomes a member of the club or ceases to visit.

2.5 A visitor under 2.3(ii) or 2.3(iii) will be required to pay a \$10 race entry fee.

2.6 Visitors may only sail at Rye Yacht Club for a maximum of three race days per season, without becoming members of the club.

2.7 Skippers and eligible boats may enter on the day of the race up to 45 minutes before the start of the race using the Sign on Sheets. Entries for visitors must be accompanied by the appropriate fee. (See 2.5)

- 2.8 All crews shall conform to the current Yachting Australia membership requirements for club racing in Victoria (Yachting Australia Silver Membership).
- 2.9 Signing 'on' and 'off' for each race is a condition of entry. Signing 'on' shall deem a skipper to be an entrant.

3. Divisions

- 3.1 For all races Divisions will be:
- i. "A" Trailable monohull yachts
 - ii. "B" Off-the-Beach monohulls (except for Division E yachts)
 - iii. "C" Off-the Beach multihulls
 - iv. "D" Approved novice skippers
 - v. "E" 29'ers and RS-Fevas
- 3.2 For all events Divisions A, B and C will start separately, with the exception of Course 8; Divisions D and E- may be started with Division B.
- 3.3 For clarity, it shall be at the sole discretion of the Sailing Sub-Committee as to the eligibility of skippers to race in Division D.
- The intent of Division D is to provide novice and green fleet skippers an opportunity to race in the standard course area. As a guide, skippers shall be eligible to compete in Division D during their first complete season of racing.***

4. Fees

- 4.1 The fee for visitors shall be that set out in Para 2.5
- 4.2 Casual launch fee for Trailable yachts is \$20 per launch.
- 4.3 Fees are to be paid prior to racing.

5. Schedule

- 5.1 The date and time of warning signal for each race is published in the Sailing Program 2016-17 attached at Addendum A.
- 5.2 An information session will held approximately 1 hour prior to the Warning Signal on the day of race.
- 5.2 Any amendments to this program during the season will be posted on the Club Notice Boards and published in the Club Newsletter.

6. Measurements

- 6.1 Measurement is not required but upon request of the Rear Commodore or Sailing Sub-Committee Compliance Officer, a boat shall submit proof of holding a valid measurement or rating certificate.

7. Sailing Instructions

- 7.1 Copies of the Sailing Instructions will be available to all Club members prior to the start of the season and to visitors prior to the race.
- 7.2 Sailing Instructions will also be posted on the Club Notice Board.
- 7.3 A (returnable) copy can be obtained from the Control Tower prior to a race.

8. Venue

- 8.1 The races will be conducted from Rye Yacht Club, which is located on the foreshore of Port Phillip Bay at Rye, Victoria.
- 8.2 The racing area will be the water of Capel Sound and the surrounding Port Phillip Bay.

9. The Courses

- 9.1 The Courses will be various forms of 'around the buoys' races such as triangles, and windward and return races, in Port Phillip Bay as described in the Sailing Instructions.

10. Races

- 10.1 Where few boats sign-on for any particular event, the decision to conduct a race is at the discretion of the Sailing Sub-Committee.

11. Scoring

- 11.1 All series will be scored as provided in Appendix A of the RRS using the Low Point Scoring System, except as may be modified at the discretion of the Sailing Sub-Committee.
- 11.2 Under the club scoring system, members paying sailing fees are deemed to be eligible for all club events.
- 11.3 Visitors are deemed to be entrants only for the event or series for which they pay fees.
- 11.4 For the purposes of scoring the total number of entrants in a series is deemed to be the total number of entrants that have Signed 'on' for a race during the series.
- 11.5 For purposes of scoring, the entire sailing program is deemed to be a series longer than a regatta and scored accordingly. (Ref: RRS App. A9).
- 11.6 Rostered members - If a club member is rostered for duty they shall be awarded the average of points for races they have sailed for the series and shall be included towards series eligibility as per "Conditions Applying to these Series", Addendum C

12. Radio Communications

12.1 For communication with Rye Yacht Club during events listed on the Race Program, the following radio frequencies are to be used:

- i. Marine Band 27MHz
 - a. Emergency - Channel 88
 - b. Club - Channel 94
- ii. Marine Band VHF
 - a. Emergency - Channel 16
 - b. Club (Saturday and Sunday) - Channel 71
 - c. Club (Weekdays) - Channel 73

13. Prizes

13.1 Trophies will be awarded as per Addendum B.

14. Class Status

14.1 To qualify for Class status and a Class Trophy, there must be five yachts on the club register on or before 30th December in the club year. Three of these must have started in at least the minimum number of qualifying races of the club championship races sailed.

15. Trophies Awarded to Skippers

15.1 Trophies are awarded to the skipper, not the boat. If a boat is sailed by different skippers, or a skipper sails in a different boat, each skipper/boat shall be regarded as a separate entity. The skipper is defined as the helmsman for the greater part of the race.

15.2 The greater part of the race is deemed to include a start and a finish, a beat, a reach and a windward return.

16. Qualifying for Trophies

16.1 To be eligible for trophies, skippers must start in at least the minimum number of heats for trophy eligibility as set out in the table of Conditions Applying for These Series in Addendum C for the particular event.

16.2 These conditions may be amended by the Sailing Committee at the end of the season in the event of the minimum requirements being unable to be met due to cancellation of races outside the control of the Sailing Committee.

17. Insurance

17.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance having a minimum cover of \$5 million.

17.2 While a boat may not carry normal theft or damage insurance, it is a requirement to have third-party liability insurance cover as a protection to members and the general public.

18. Disclaimer of Liability

18.1 Competitors participate in Rye Yacht Club events entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race.

18.2 Rye Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, or prior to, or during, or after the event.
