SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. REGATTA OFFICE, NOTICE BOARD, FLAG POLE LOCATION, SIGNALS & CHANGES TO SIs

- The Regatta Office and Notice Board is outside the change-rooms and the flagpole is directly above on the first floor.
- RRS S3 is replaced with, amendments to the SI made ashore will be posted at least 45 mins before the start of any race affected. Amendments made afloat will be signalled by the display of flag L with 5 sound signals. The Race Committee may communicate these either verbally or in writing.
- When the AP flag is displayed ashore, 60 mins is replaced with 30 mins. This changes RRS S4.2.
- The target is 3 to 4 Races per Day and 12 Races in total.

2. SIGN ON – SIGN OFF

Boats shall sign on before going afloat and sign off at the first reasonable opportunity upon returning ashore (at Regatta Office).

3. FIRST WARNING SIGNALS

Monday 22nd Jan 11:00

Tue-Thu 23rd to 25th 10:30

4. TIME LIMITS

Target Race Time 30 mins

Finishing window 15 mins

Boats not finishing in the finish window may be allocated a score. Changes RRS 35, A4, A5 & S12.3
No warning signal will be made after 16:30 on the last day of racing.

5. CLASS FLAG

Class Flag = "A"

8. PENALTIES AT THE TIME OF AN INCIDENT

- For the multihull class(es) rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

6. MARKS

Start Pin Staff on RC

Boat with Orange flag

Start end Orange round

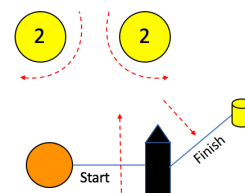
buoy
